A biosketch

Cyril Julie is the First Rand Chair Foundation in Mathematics Education at the University of the Western Cape. He has also held the position Professor in Mathematics Education at the University of Agder in Norway and visiting Professor at the University of Bergen. He has been involved in Mathematics Education since the early 1970s as a teacher, developer of resources for school Mathematics, conceptualiser and director of support programmes in Mathematics for learners and teachers. He also led the Graduate Studies in Science, Mathematics and Technology Education programme – a multi-national project to develop research capacity in Sub-Saharan countries through doctoral studies.

Cyril Julie was instrumental in establishing the Association for Mathematics Education of South Africa (AMESA) and he is a member of the Agder Society of Letters and Science in Norway. He is currently directing the Local Evidence-Driven Improvement of Mathematics Teaching And Learning Initiative (LEDIMTALI) at the University of the Western Cape.
