

ICTMA-18 Development Fund

One of the aims of the ICTMA Community is to have a balanced representation from all over the world among the presenters at ICTMA conferences. In order to achieve this goal a development fund has been established to assist delegates from non-affluent countries to attend ICTMA-18. Priority will be given to applicants from less-affluent countries.

Application for Support

Only a limited number of applicants will be supported, depending on available funds. Grants will be given as partial support towards delegates' registration fees, but will not cover the whole amount. Travel and accommodation cannot be supported.

Selection criteria

- Geographic representation of an applicant and the particular mathematics educational situation in the applicant's country.
- An accepted abstract for ICTMA-18.
- Only one of the authors of a particular abstract will be eligible to apply for a grant.
- The applicant's financial situation.

Application process

Participants who consider themselves eligible for an ICTMA-18 grant are encouraged to send a grant application to the Conference organisers at hwessels@sun.ac.za between the 1st of March and the 10th of April 2017. No applications will be accepted after this date.

Applications should be sent only in electronic form as one pdf-file including:

- Name and complete home address
- e-mail-address
- Current institute with full address, academic position
- Submitted paper or poster
- Academic CV
- List of publications
- A written motivation of a maximum of 300 words as why the applicant would need a grant.
- A short statement about the potential contribution to the community after returning from ICTMA-18.
- Optional: a letter of recommendation by a Master or PhD supervisor or colleague.

Decisions of the Development Fund Committee will be communicated to applicants during the last week of April 2017.
